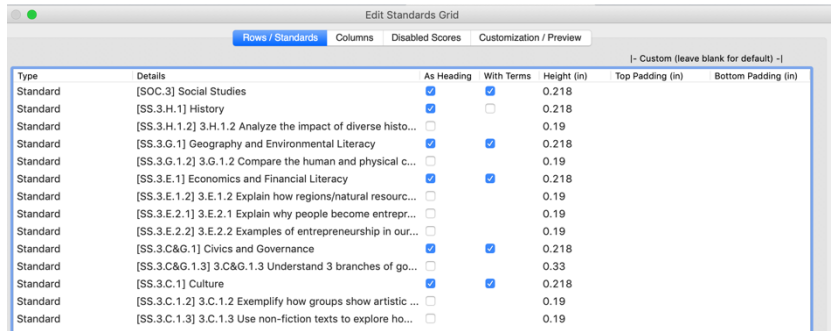




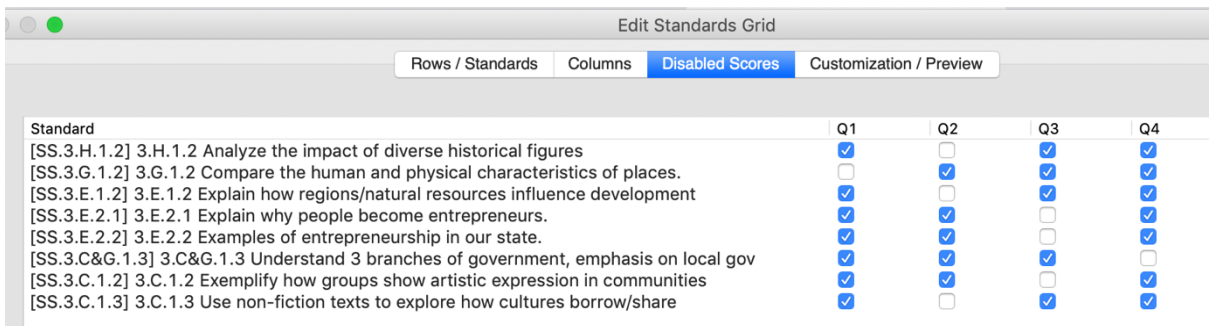
ParkBench Version 3.1 - Gray Boxes – Disabling Scores

For years, we've had to create boxes to cover specific standards that were not assessed in a given term. To say the least- it was tedious work to align a box within a standard term grid! NOW it's so so much easier thanks to the new features of Version 3.1

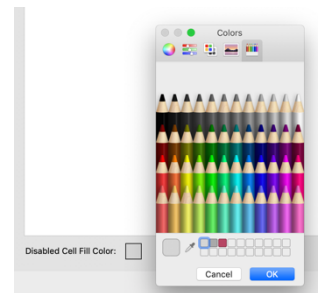
Once you select your standards and mark the standards which are headers on the ROWS/STANDARD TAB



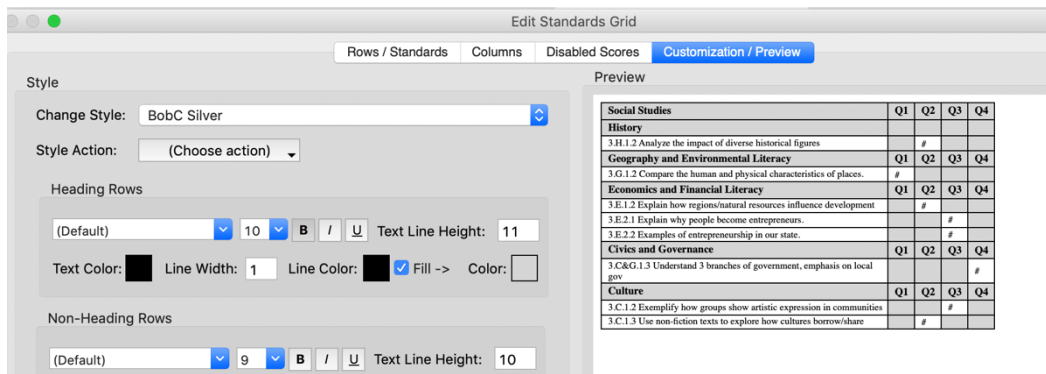
You move to the new feature tab – called Disabled Scores. ParkBench Visual PST 3.1 knows enough NOT to list the headers that you previously selected (above) and only list the standards and terms. You simply check the boxes that you want disabled and a GRAY BOX** (perfectly sized) will appear.



Actually your box doesn't necessarily have to be gray as you are provided with a color picker in the lower right of the Disabled Scores page.



Once you are done – the shaded boxes will appear on the Customization/Preview page. You can match the color of your headers by selecting the Bobc Silver style as the default Disabled Cell Fill Color is Silver!
