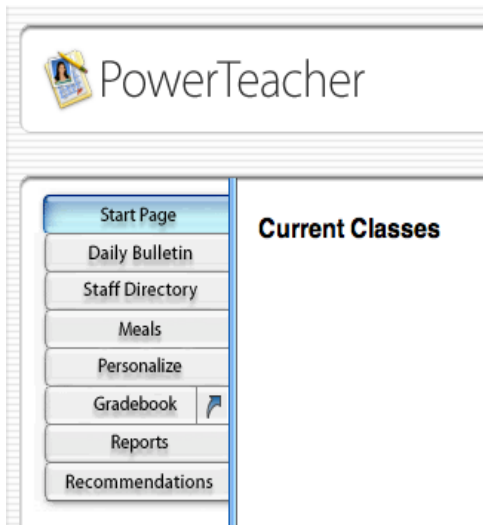
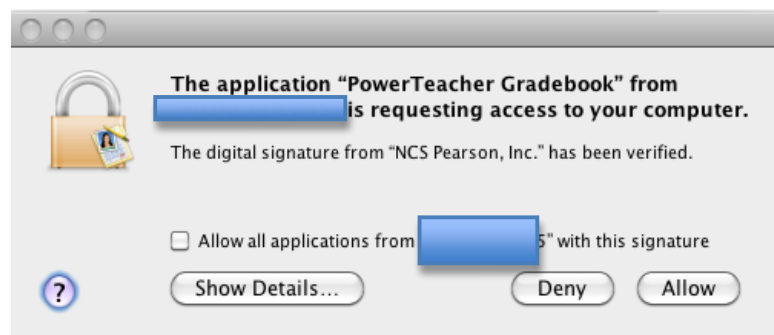


How to – Launch the Web Gradebook


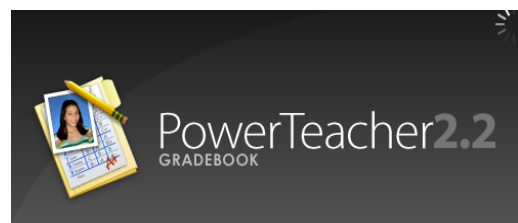


1. Log onto your PowerSchool URL that you have bookmarked.
