



# RETIRING STANDARDS...

If you build it, they will come  
If you build it, they will change it!



Inevitably your standards will change possibly in light of Common Core. Hopefully your administration will not insist on them changing during the middle of an academic year. When standards do change and I'm not talking about wordsmithing a few words, you may have to change your SBRC as well as disassociate the old standards from the current courses. Doing this last piece prevents NEW and OLD standards from appearing in a teachers Gradebook.

Why can't you just delete them? You have grades associated to those standards and you may need to print report cards from the past years.



Here's one way of handing the retirement of standards:

1. Find all the old standards and if you have access to DDA, remove the course association by modifying the courses to equal BLANK.
