This might be resolved by experimenting with the code listed above is to create a decode statement for each standard that pulls only those grades from the current term that the report cards are being printed from. Whomever is printing the report cards would have to remember to be printing out of the correct term. This would require lots of work and time most districts do not have.

The best practices suggestion I have at this time for those few teachers who during the small grading window for Q1 that extends into Q2, if assignments are created, do not grade associated standards until the report cards are printed and are sent home. If no grades for associated standards are submitted, at time of printing, no scores will appear in the next term.
